

2016 Grenache Rosé Columbia Valley

“(whole-cluster-pressed; this south-facing bench block in the Horse Heaven Hills is grown specifically for rosé): Full orange-pink. Slightly yeasty aromas of watermelon and red berries, along with a resinous nuance. Round, mouthfilling wine with a touch of raspberry sweetness buffered by bright citricity and firm acidity. This actually tastes sweeter than its two grams r.s. but finishes quite dry.” – Stephen Tanzer
